



## Facebook Fill-in System

Captains are responsible for organising their teams each week. It is recommended that all captains have a Facebook account as this will be the only means of receiving contact details of fill-ins from centre staff. Captains must add the Fill-in Coordinator, Lawrie Trotman, as a friend in order to be invited to join the group in which the names and phone numbers of fill-ins for each division are recorded.

Each week, a list of known available and unavailable players will be posted and captains must communicate who they have called and who is filling in for them. This will ensure that players are not contacted multiple times in one week. Any other fill-ins required must be sourced from personal contacts. Payments for play by fill-ins are to be managed by captains.

**Rules of Play:**

1. Please see the office before commencing play each week so staff can provide you with your court number, balls, score sheets and any additional information.
2. All players must be at the courts 15 minutes before the designated start time. Use only the court allocated for your fixture. Play commences on a first in, first served basis – it is not necessary to follow the order of the score sheet. A forfeit may be claimed after 5 minutes if no other match can commence.
3. Keep warm ups to 5 minutes – if you need additional time, arrive early and you may use courts where available (please check with the office first).
4. Any match not completed by the designated end time is to be recorded at the score at that time. Please manage your time accordingly and return score sheets and balls to the office at the end of the night.
5. Ensure score sheets are properly completed, with the full names of fill-ins added when necessary. This ensures that each team receives their points and players can be correctly graded. Captains must ensure a player is available for start of play and are responsible for contacting opposing captains for playing order changes as well the club for forfeits.
6. In the event of wet weather, fixtures will only be cancelled half an hour before the commencement of play via recorded message on 3899 8110. If play has commenced, the staff member on site will only cancel play after half an hour of rain. If there are any safety concerns, the staff member has the authority to cease play without question. Wet weather credits will only be issued to participants who do not play at least 1 full set on the day.
